## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR INVESTORS IN SWITZERLAND

---

This Country Supplement forms part of, and should be read in conjunction with, the prospectus dated 1 May 2026 and the Sub-Funds' Supplements and this "Additional information for investors in Switzerland", as may be further amended from time to time (the "Prospectus") for KraneShares ICAV (the "ICAV"). Please refer to the "Fees and Expenses" section of the Prospectus for further information on the fees associated with an investment in the ICAV.

The Shares of the ICAV shall be offered or advertised in Switzerland exclusively to qualified investors as defined by Article 10 of the Collective Investment Schemes Act, as amended from time to time ("Qualified Investors"). The ICAV has not been approved by the Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority for offering in Switzerland to non-qualified investors.

**6. Retrocessions and Rebates**

**6.1 Retrocessions**

The Management Company or Investment Manager may pay part or all of its fees to any person that invests in or provides services to the ICAV or in respect of any Sub-Fund in the form of a retrocessions, as further described in the Prospectus.

Retrocessions are not deemed to be rebates even if they are ultimately passed on, in full or in part, to the investors.

The recipients of the retrocessions must ensure transparent disclosure and inform investors, unsolicited and free of charge, about the amount of remuneration they may receive for distribution.

#### 6.2 Rebates

The ICAV and its affiliates do not pay rebates, defined as payments by the ICAV and its affiliates directly to investors from a fee or cost charged to the Sub-Fund with the purpose of reducing the said fee or cost to an agreed amount.

### **7. Place of performance and jurisdiction**

For Shares of a Sub-Fund offered in Switzerland, the place of execution shall be the registered office of the Representative in Switzerland. The place of jurisdiction shall be at the registered office of the Representative in Switzerland, or at the registered office or domicile of the investor.
