WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

Type: KraneShares MSCI China A 50 Connect UCITS ETF (the "Fund") is a sub-fund of KraneShares ICAV, an Irish collective asset-management vehicle ("ICAV") constituted as an umbrella fund with segregated liability between sub-funds with registration number C181441 and authorised by the Central Bank of Ireland as a UCITS pursuant to the European Communities (Undertakings for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities) Regulations 2011, as amended. Segregated liability between sub-funds means that the assets and liabilities of each sub-fund are segregated by law, so that an investor should have no claims over the assets of a sub-fund in which they do not own shares. The prospectus and periodic reports are prepared for KraneShares ICAV at umbrella level. Shares in the Fund may not be converted into shares in another sub-fund or from one share class in the Fund into another share class within the same sub-fund.

Objectives: The Fund seeks to deliver the performance of Chinese Renminbi Companies denominated equity securities listed on the Shenzhen or Shanghai Stock Exchanges.

Investment Policy: The Fund is passively managed and will seek to achieve its objective by passively tracking the performance of the MSCI China A 50 Connect Index (the "Index") as closely as possible. Under normal circumstances, the Fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets in securities of China Renminbi Companies or in depositary receipts representing securities of the Index. The Index is derived from the MSCI China A Index (the "Parent Index") which is, in turn, derived from the MSCI China A International Index but only includes securities that are accessible through the Stock Connect Programs. The Fund invests primarily in securities which are included in the Index. The Index's constituents are taken from the Parent Index and it aims to reflect the performance of the 50 largest securities representing each Global Industry Classification Standard sector and reflect the sector weight allocation of the Parent Index. The Fund seeks to hold all the securities of the Index with the approximate weightings that they have in the Index. The Fund seeks to create a near mirror image of the Index but may, in certain circumstances purchase securities that are not included in the Index. Although the Index is generally well diversified, because of the market it reflects, depending on market conditions, the Fund may, in order to track the Index accurately, hold positions in individual constituents of the Index up to 20% of the Fund's Net Asset Value. The Fund does not intend to use financial derivative instruments. The Fund may also invest up to 10% of its net asset value in other regulated collective investment schemes, including other exchange traded funds. The Fund may engage in securities lending but does not intend to use repurchase agreements or total return swaps. The Fund's income will be reinvested, and the Fund does not intend to declare dividends. Save in exceptional circumstances, the Fund will only issue and redeem shares of the Fund ("Shares") to certain institutional investors. However, other investors may purchase or sell Shares through brokers on or one more stock exchanges. The Shares trade on these stock exchanges at market prices which may fluctuate throughout the day. Market prices may be greater or less than the daily net asset value of the Fund. Shareholders may redeem Shares on any Business Day (as defined in the fund supplement) and any other day at the Directors' discretion provided Shareholders are notified in advance. Intended Retail Investors: Typical investors in the Fund are expected to be investors who are seeking exposure to the performance of RMB A-Share and are prepared to accept the risks associated with an investment of this type.

Term: The Fund has no maturity date. The Management Company is not entitled to terminate the Fund unilaterally. The Fund may be terminated unilaterally by Kranshares ICAV under certain circumstances as set out in the prospectus for Kranshares ICAV.

WHAT HAPPENS IF WAYSTONE MANAGEMENT COMPANY (IE) LIMITED IS UNABLE TO PAY OUT?

To protect you, the assets of the Fund are held with SEI Investments – Depositary and Custodial Services (Ireland) Limited (the "Depositary"). The Depositary is a separate regulated entity which performs safekeeping duties for the Fund's assets. In the event of the insolvency of the Management Company, the Fund's assets in the safekeeping of the Depositary will not be affected. Should the Fund default, the Depositary would preserve the Fund's assets so that they could be liquidated and the proceeds distributed to the investors. In the worst case, however, you could lose your entire investment. You are not covered by a national compensation scheme.
